In preparation for the Year 10 Divinity mock on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December, the Divinity Department will provide afterschool tuition sessions starting from next week until their mock from 3.35-4.20pm in their Divinity classrooms.

In order to maximise their prospects of GCSE success both in the forthcoming mocks and next summer, staff have indicated that your child should do their best to attend the weekly sessions after school on the allocated day.

With any after school GCSE tuition sessions, students should recognise that staff are giving up their own time to help support them with their studies – where there is no unavoidable outside commitment, therefore, sessions should be attended without the need for staff to do any cajoling.

There is no fee for these spaces this year, but because spaces are limited, students do need to inform the office as early as possible that they want to book a seat. This minibus will leave St Martin's at approximately 4:30pm and can drop students off at landmark locations in Hinckley, Barwell, Earl Shilton and Stoney Stanton. Students wishing to book a place on the minibus should see Mrs Evans in reception on the day of the tuition session in order to do so.
