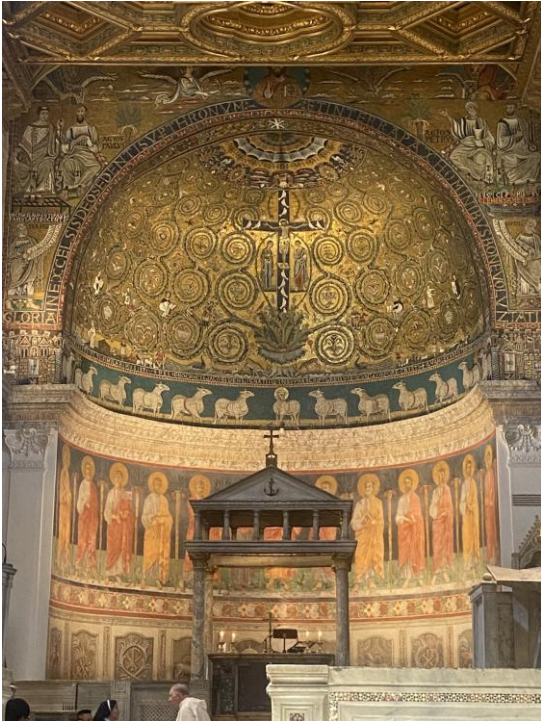

*Each week I will look at behaviour in Divinity and with Mrs McKnight if it is poor- parents/carers will be phoned. No one disturbs the learning of others.



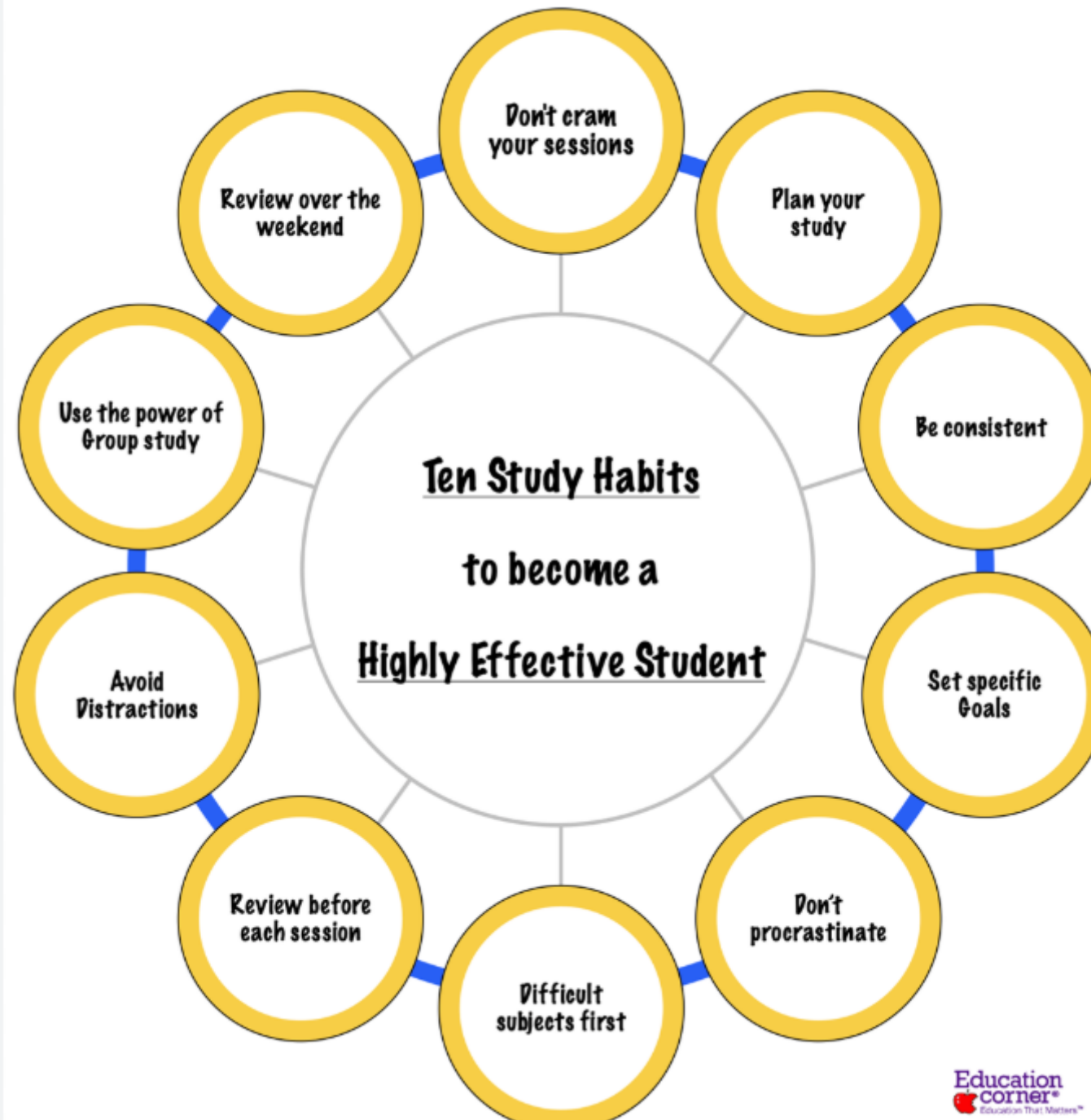

*Praise will be acknowledged for trying your best, for excellent work; revising; answering questions.

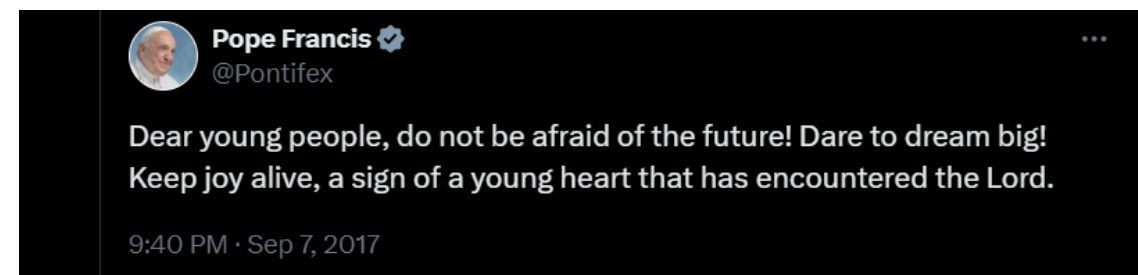
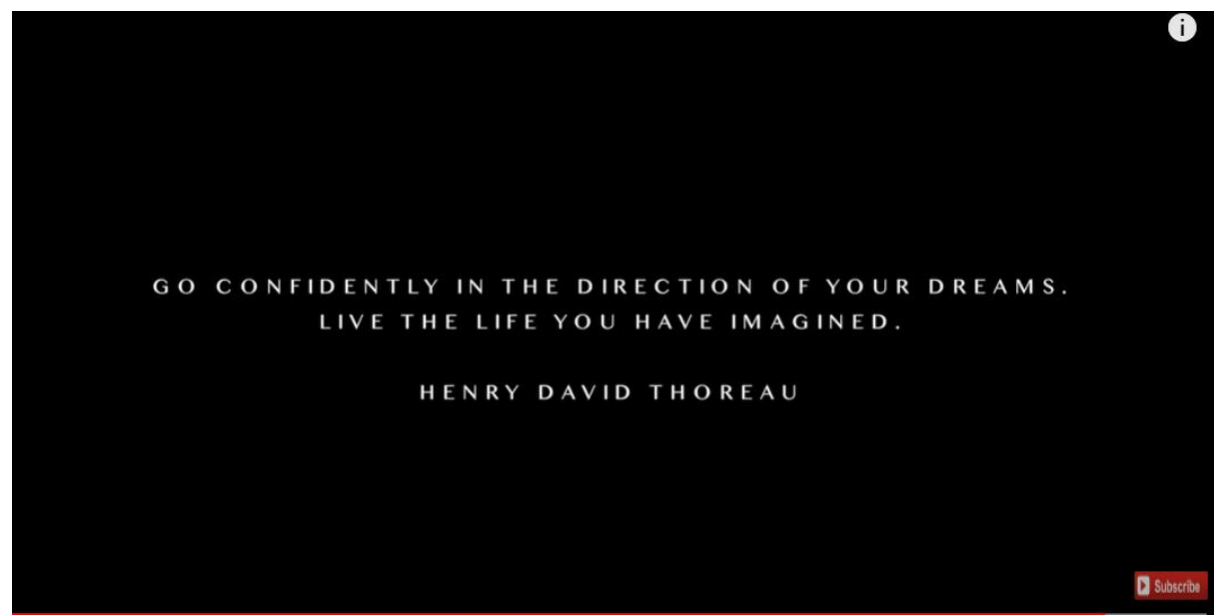
